

Chapter Guidelines for Awards of Excellence

Recognizing CFPC members who have made outstanding contributions in the past 12 to 24 months to the discipline of family medicine

DEADLINES:

The deadline for members to submit their nominations for the Awards of Excellence to the Manitoba Chapter Office is JANUARY 20TH, 2012.

REQUIREMENTS:

These awards were created as a way for the College to recognize at the national level family physicians who are meritorious and recognized at the Provincial Chapter level. The Awards of Excellence recognize CFPC members who, **in the past 12 to 24 months**, have made outstanding contributions to one or more of the following:

- patient care,
- community service,
- hospital or health care institutions,
- College activities (National and Chapter),
- teaching, research, or other elements of the discipline of family medicine

ELIGIBILITY:

- Nominee must be a member in good standing
- Nominations can be from members or the public.
- Groups and family medicine residents are eligible.
- Runners-up to Family Physician of the Year can be considered.
- Members can be re-nominated in subsequent years for new outstanding achievements.
- Chapters may recognize their recipients at their ASA and other provincial events.
- The CFPC will acknowledge recipients at FMF and publish the names in the CFP, and the awards website
- Up to 50 Awards of Excellence be given per year with a maximum from each Chapter based on the following formula:
