Starting in 2015, watch for a new and improved Mainpro! "Mainpro+" brings many exciting changes:

- New, user-friendly online reporting tool
- Simplified reporting categories
- Select CPD activities that earn up to 3X more credit
- More practice activities eligible for credits

What will remain the same?

A few important aspects of Mainpro+ will not be different from the current system:

- Five-year reporting cycle
- Minimum of 250 total credits per cycle, and a minimum of 25 credits to earn and report annually
- Minimum 125 CERTIFIED credits per cycle
- Mandatory online reporting
- Friendly and supportive CPD staff available to assist you
