

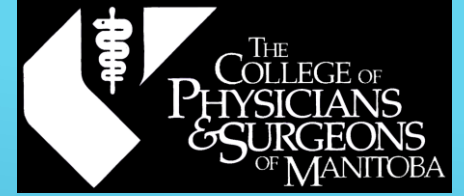

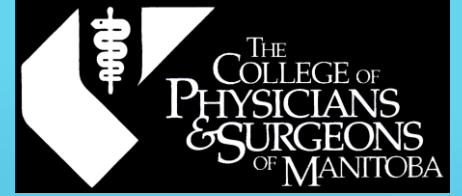

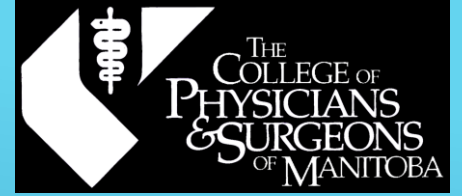

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Why?



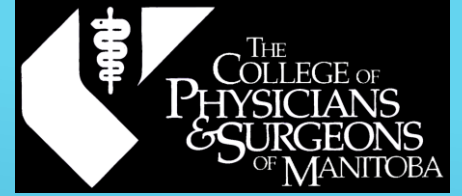
- ▶ **Mandate of the College is to ensure provision of safe care to Manitobans – public safety**

What?



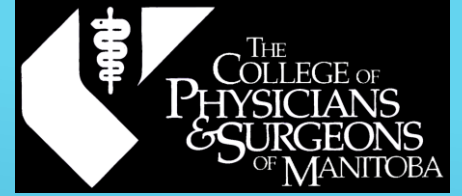
- ▶ Former use of Manitoba Physician Achievement Review (MPAR)
- ▶ Move to individualized analysis of a member's practice
- ▶ Incorporate peer review
- ▶ Identify learning needs associated with your practice and patient population
- ▶ Provide practice supports

Who?



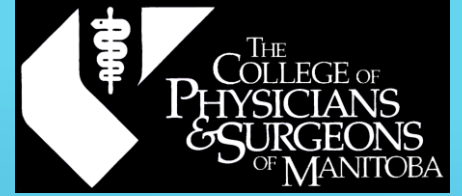
- ▶ All physicians
 - ▶ Will begin with Family Physicians
 - ▶ Reviews by peers
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When?



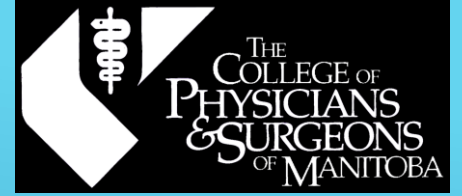
- ▶ Pilot to begin September 2018 – 50 physicians
 - ▶ Full program to begin January 2019
 - ▶ Specialists to begin January 2020
 - ▶ To run on a 7 year cycle
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Where?



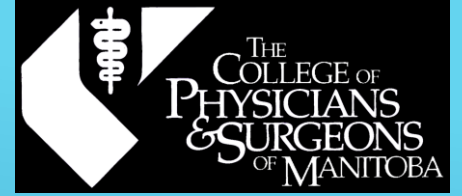
- ▶ For those participants undergoing chart review, most will be off-site for the physician (at the College offices)
 - ▶ Some participants will have on-site practice reviews, with office visits by College assessors
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How?



- ▶ Questionnaire with instructions to gather information about your practice, where you work, what type of patients you see, what type of work you do, CPD information
- ▶ Some participants will be selected for off-site chart review, multisource feedback, and/or on-site practice review
- ▶ All participants will receive feedback and practice resources
- ▶ All participants will be asked to complete a learning plan based on their individual practice needs

- ▶ Opportunity to analyze your practice
- ▶ Enables you to choose CPD opportunities that match your practice and learning needs
- ▶ Identify unique opportunities to provide better care to patient populations
